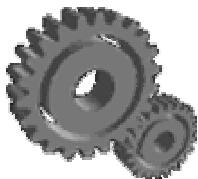

We are looking for a couple of good people...

WAID annually elects a new Sergeant-At-Arms from our distributor members. With the Bylaw changes made last year, we will also be electing a new general Board Member from the manufacturer membership.

The officers of the organization are comprised solely from distributors. One person is elected to the Sergeant-At-Arms position and annually progresses through all four offices, Secretary/Treasurer, Vice President, and finally President. The President then retires to the advisory position of Immediate Past President.

A newly added "rotation" of the existing three manufacturer Board positions will give others the chance to serve WAID while maintaining continuity of the Board of Directors. For lack of a better title, the positions will simply be numbered as: Seat 1, Seat 2, and Seat 3. The director at Seat 1 will retire from the Board at the Annual Convention and the other two remaining directors will move to the next Seat leaving Seat 3 open for election.

To recap: Open for election is the Sergeant-At-Arms to be elected from the distributor members and Seat 3 to be elected from the manufacturer members.
